

A motion by Tennessee, South Dakota and Wisconsin to adopt a rule relating to Governing Board due dates that fall on a weekend:

Rule 806.1 Administration of Governing Board

Rule 806.1.4 – Communications Policies

A. The due date for filing any documents with the Governing Board, the executive director, any committee of the Governing Board, or the State and Local Advisory Council pursuant to this Agreement, or the rules or by-laws of the Governing Board shall be on the next succeeding day if the date falls on a Saturday, or Sunday or a legal public holiday. Legal public holiday has the same meaning as used in 5 U.S.C. 6013(a) with the application of 5 U.S.C. 6103(b)(1) and (2) for holidays falling on a weekend day.

B. For purposes of Sections 318 and 319 of the Agreement, each member state shall notify the Governing Board of its legal holidays. The Governing Board shall post such dates on its website. A state’s legal holidays are those provided by state law and need not conform to the definition of “legal public holiday” in paragraph A of this rule.

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
