Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Indiana, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Revenue ("DOR"), I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Indiana is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2020.

No changes have been made to Indiana statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Indiana's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2019.
