Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Indiana, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Revenue (the "Department" or "DOR") I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Indiana is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of July 1, 2026.

No changes have been made to Indiana's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Indiana's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since July 1, 2025.

As part of this annual recertification, Indiana updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices) which reflect Indiana's laws enacted through July 1, 2026, and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2026.
