Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Minnesota, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as the designee of the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Revenue, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Minnesota is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2020.

No changes have been made to Minnesota's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Minnesota's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2019.
