Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of North Dakota, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as North Dakota State Tax Commissioner, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that North Dakota is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2020.

No changes have been made to North Dakota statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect North Dakota's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2019.
