Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the State of New Jersey, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Deputy Director of the New Jersey Division of Taxation, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that New Jersey is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2022.

No changes have been made to New Jersey's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect New Jersey's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2021.

As part of this annual recertification, New Jersey updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices) that reflect New Jersey's laws as enacted through August 1, 2022 and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2022.
