Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the State of Nevada, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Executive Director of the Nevada Department of Taxation, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Nevada is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of July 1, 2026.

No changes have been made to Nevada's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Nevada's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since July 1, 2025.

As part of this annual recertification, Nevada updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices) which reflect Nevada's laws enacted through June 30, 2026, and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2026.
