Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement (“Agreement”) and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Ohio, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Tax Commissioner of the Ohio Department of Taxation, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Ohio is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of the date of this letter.

The following bills made changes to Ohio’s statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Ohio’s compliance with the terms of the Agreement.
