Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Oklahoma, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Chairman of the Oklahoma Tax Commission, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Oklahoma is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of July 1, 2019.

No changes have been made to Oklahoma's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Oklahoma's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2018.
