Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of South Dakota, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Secretary of the South Dakota Department of Revenue, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that South Dakota is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2020.

No changes have been made to South Dakota's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect South Dakota's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2019.

As part of this annual recertification, South Dakota updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix that reflect South Dakota's laws as enacted through July 20, 2020 and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning July 27, 2020.
