Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of South Dakota, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Secretary of the South Dakota Department of Revenue, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that South Dakota is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2026.

No changes have been made to South Dakota's statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect South Dakota's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2025.

As part of this annual recertification, South Dakota updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices) which reflect South Dakota's laws enacted through July 31, 2026, and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2026.
