Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the state of Vermont, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Commissioner of the Department of Taxes, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Vermont is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of August 1, 2022.

No changes have been made to Vermont statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Vermont's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since August 1, 2021.
