Pursuant to Section 803 of the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement ("Agreement") and Rule 803.1, on behalf of the State of Vermont, a Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board member state, and as Commissioner of the Vermont Department of Taxes, I hereby certify to the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board that Vermont is in substantial compliance with the terms of the Agreement as of July 1, 2024.

No changes have been made to Vermont statutes, rules, regulations, or other authorities that could affect Vermont's compliance with the terms of the Agreement since July 1, 2023.

As part of this annual recertification, Vermont updated its Online Certificate of Compliance and Taxability Matrix (Part 1 – Library of Definitions and Part 2 – Tax Administration Practices), which reflect Vermont's laws enacted through July 31, 2024, and has approved them to be published on the Streamlined Sales Tax Governing Board website beginning August 1, 2024.
