51030-51270: This year, Vermont legislature passed H.536, which included a change for the exemption available for animal drugs. Now, animal drugs are only exempt from sales and use tax if there is a prescription. These items were changed on the Vermont matrix to reflect this amendment.

30050: It came to our attention recently that this item was incorrectly entered under our law. There has been no law change. Vermont law taxes the sale of prewritten computer software that is delivered electronically. Software as a service, however, continues to be a non-taxed service under Vermont law (as the comment continues to explain).
